

Recreation Commission Meeting Minutes

1. Approval of meeting minutes from Thursday, April 13, 2023- Motion made by Julie Anders with a second by Leslie Trussler, all approved.

2. Programs Report

A. Amazing Family Night- 380 Participants, Unity Medical sponsored the event.

B. AAU Tournaments-

C. Summer Day Camp- Full with a wait list

D. Summer Swim Lessons- swim lessons open for enrollment, have 6 instructors , plus Becki Johnson will teach the Infant/Toddler and Parent class.

3. Maintenance

A. Chiller

- Lee Company to Replace Sensor and Refrigerant = \$8,130.00
- Replace Sensor = \$4,385.00
- Add 136 lbs. of Refrigerant = \$3,745.00

B. Basketball Gym HVAC Unit – the pipe burst that fed hot/cold water. C&H has ordered the part and expect it to take 7-10 days to receive. Water got on the gym floor a 60' x 40' area, no signs of damage yet.

C. Pool Pump Room Fire Sprinkler System- sprung a leak, the pipe touches another pipe and caused electrolysis and it deteriorated the pipe. Jarret Fire System recommends that the whole system needs to be replaced in the room. Waiting on a price. It currently functions but leaking. When the hole gets bigger there is no pressure in the lines and an alarm is set off.

D. Hunter Gattis Memorial Playground- shut down the section closest to the parking lot. Spoke with Norma Gattis to make her aware. The whole playground needs to be replaced. Met with Landscape Structures representative and the playground is not worth rehabbing and needs to be replaced down. Julie Anders asked about the name and AJ Fox explained it is in memorial of a young boy who drowned. AJ Fox recommends a new playground and showed examples.

4. Old Business

A. Grant Project Updates

- Diabetes A - Farmers Market- Becki Johnson is trying to get vendors.
- LPRF - Ball Field Lighting- waiting on St. John's to complete ADA Drawings.

B. Recreation Center Roof Replacement- currently being replaced, will take 90-days to complete.

C. Recreation Center Wellness Room Floor Bid- The tile color will be Raging Red and a 1" thick tile system.

D. Maintenance Technician Position- Introduced Jonathan Schomburg who is the new Technician. Bill McKinley left and Nathan Frasier will be moved into his position full-time.

E. Funds from Roof Project to Aquatics Project- \$67,000 has been approved to move to Aquatics and \$100,000 will remain for change orders.

5. New Business

A. Storm Damage- T-ball field light pole blew over. The field will only be used during daylight hours.

B. Concession Prices- Becki Johnson reviewed the estimated 10 % increase on most items. Julie Anders made a motion to approve, Stan Rogers made a second motion, and all approved.
