

**CITY OF MANCHESTER
STREET COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

The Street Committee of the City of Manchester met in a session on Thursday, June 8, 2023 at 5:30 pm.

Present for the meeting were: Alderman Messick, Alderman Anderson, Public Works Director Gannon, Office Manager Moore, Mr. Mike Clanton with Curl Construction

Absent: Alderman French

First Item discussed was to approve the street committee minutes from past meeting. Alderman Anderson made motion to approve the minutes, Second by Alderman Messick Passed 2-0

Second Item was comments from citizens. None

Third item discussed was the Dead end of Spring Street. Mr. Mike Clanton with Curl Construction spoke about the dead end of Spring St. They are wanting to build some apartments at the end of the street. They are wanting to widen the street, but they want the city to pave the street once they are done. There was some further discussion on this. No motion was made

Fourth item discussed was the speed limit on Expressway Dr. Alderman Anderson made a motion to change the speed limit from 20 mph to 30 mph on Expressway Dr, Second by Alderman Messick Passed 2-0

Fifth item discussed was street light on Elm St. Alderman Anderson made a motion to go ahead and install the street light, Second by Alderman Messick Passed 2-0

Sixth item discussed was a stop sign on Edgewood Dr and Third Ave. Alderman Anderson had spoken with the police chief and he would like to conduct a survey on this. There was some more discussion on this. Alderman Anderson made a motion to postpone, Second by Alderman Messick Passed 2-0

Seventh item discussed was sidewalk update. Director Gannon stated that they were pouring concrete and forming more sidewalk on Coffee St. Hillschapel Rd sidewalk – still working on getting easements. There was some further discussion on this

Eighth item discussed was the bridge on the Old Tullahoma Hwy (Wiley Creek Bridge). Director Gannon stated that TDOT inspects the bridges every year and send out a report. Director Gannon stated that he is working with the County Highway Dept to see if we can get this replaced. There was some further discussion on this.
